What is the Good News?

What is the Good News? **G.R.A.C.E. = God's Riches At Christ's Expense**

The Bible tells us that we were lost, rebellious, and dead, separated from God and condemned in our sins with no ability to save ourselves... "But God, who is rich in mercy, because of his great love for us, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in sin—it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast." (paraphrase of Ephesians 2:1-10).

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him." – *John 3:16-17*

"God made him (Jesus) who knew no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God." – *2 Corinthians 5:21*

"For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you through his poverty might become rich." – *2 Corinthians 8:9*

"This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins." – *1 John 4:9-10*
